

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

### 1. Eligibility :

Before filling the Application Form, the candidate should ascertain whether he/she fulfils all the requirements and is eligible for admission to MD/MS/ Diploma/MDS Course. The conditions of eligibility are mentioned in Rule No. 15 of Chapter - 1 of this Rule book.

Candidate's Responsibility : Candidates who appear in the test would do so at their own risk and responsibility so far as their eligibility is concerned. Hence, candidates are advised to ascertain their eligibility before applying.

### 2. Examination Cities :

The test will be conducted at examination centres in the following cities of Madhya Pradesh : Bhopal, Indore, Gwalior and Jabalpur.

### 3. Availability of Application Form :

(a) The Application Forms for the test will be available from MPPEB counter and designated institutions on cash payment of Rs. 1000/- (Cost of Application form includes the Test Fee) from 17-03-2008 to 31-03-2008.

- (b) Applications forms may also be obtained by post from the MPPEB office by submitting a request letter accompanied by an account payee Bank Draft/Banker's Cheque of Rs. 1050/- drawn in favour of Madhya Pradesh Vyavsayik Pareeksha Mandal, Bhopal (or M.P. Professional Examination Board, Bhopal) drawn on any Nationalized Bank payable at Bhopal. The application form, shall be sent to the candidate by Registered post or Speed Post (where facility exists), However, MPPEB shall not be responsible for any loss/delay in postal transit. Such a request letter should reach MPPEB office on or before **31-03-2008**.
- (c) Candidate can fill up the application form online through the website of the Board **www.vyapam.nic.in** or **www.mponline.gov.in**. In such cases the test fee can also be paid online.
4. Duly filled OMR application form must be sent by registered post so as to reach MPPEB or submitted in person at MPPEB office, Bhopal on or before **04.04.2008**
5. In-Service candidates shall have to submit their OMR application form as mentioned at S.No. 4, and will have to submit their In-Service form in prescribed form (Form-8 given in the Rule book) to Director, Health Services, 4th floor, Satpura Bhawan, Bhopal.

**GOVERNMENT OF MADHYA PRADESH**  
**MEDICAL EDUCATION DEPARTMENT**  
**MANTRALAYA**

No. F-4-8/2007/1/55, In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 10 of the Madhya Pradesh Chikitsa Shiksha Sanstha Niyam, 1973 (No.19 of 1973), the State Government hereby makes the following rules relating to entrance to Post Graduate Medical (MD & MS) course, Post Graduate Diploma and Dental (MDS) course in Medical and Dental Colleges in the State of Madhya Pradesh.

**RULES**

**1.1 Short Title and Commencement:**

- (1) These rules may be called the Madhya Pradesh Medical and Dental Post Graduate Course Entrance Examination Rules, 2008.
- (2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Madhya Pradesh Gazette and shall remain in force for the academic year 2008.

**1.2 DEFINITIONS:** In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires,-

- (a) "Board" means the Madhya Pradesh Professional Examination Board;
- (b) "College" means **an** Autonomous Medical **or** a Dental College under the State Government;
- (c) "Examination" means the Entrance Examination conducted by the Madhya Pradesh Professional Examination Board ;
- (d) "In-Service Candidate" means, Medical officer of Public Health and Family Welfare Department, who is serving under the Government of Madhya Pradesh on regular or contract basis.
- (e) "Other Backward Classes" means Other Backward Classes as specified and laid down by the Government of Madhya Pradesh;

- (f) “Rural Area “ means the area other than Municipal Corporation area and Municipal Council area;
- (g) “Scheduled Caste” means Scheduled Castes as specified and laid down by the Government of Madhya Pradesh;
- (h) “Scheduled Tribe” means Scheduled Tribes as specified and laid down by the Government of Madhya Pradesh;
- (i) “State Government” means Government of Madhya Pradesh;
- ( j ) “Tribal Area” means area under tribal sub plan;
- (k) “MCI” means Medical Council of India;
- (l) “DCI” means Dental Council of India;

**1.3 GENERAL :**

- (1) PG Degree and Diploma courses will be governed and regulated by MCI / DCI / University / State Government / Govt. of India / Autonomous Society of the College under the rules and regulations in force as amended from time to time at the time of entrance examination, allotment, admission, as the case may be;
- (2) PG courses are full time courses for a period of three years in case of degree and two years in case of diploma from the date of admission. Students shall not be allowed to do private practice, part time job or any other job during the entire period of study.
- (3) Correct information must be furnished and produced whenever required. Before filling up the application form, candidates are advised to read and understand the Rules thoroughly and fill up complete and correct required information, failing which the applicants shall not be entitled to appear in the entrance examination or get an allotment /admission etc.
- (4) If it is found that a candidate has concealed any relevant facts and/or provided incorrect information while filling up the application form or at the time of allotment of a seat or at the time of scrutiny of the documents or at the time of his / her admission, then the admission shall be cancelled by the Dean / Principal of the College at any time and even during his/ her studies.

- (5) In-Service Candidate shall be treated on duty for appearing in examination and Counselling and shall be entitled to claim for Travelling Allowance and Dearness Allowance from the parent department as per rules.
- (6) Every candidate must abide by the admission rules of Board and has to deposit the prescribed fee.

**1.4 (1) The Students shall be entitled to :-**

- a) One weekly off (non cumulative);
  - b) Casual leave for 19 days per academic year.
  - c) Entitlement of Maternity leave without stipend during the entire tenure shall be 90 days with prior permission of the Dean/Principal. Medical certificate must be produced within ten days of proceeding on leave.
- (2) As per Madhya Pradesh Government order No. 147/4572/03/55/M.E.-1, Dated 14-01-04 Medical leave shall be 15 days per year without stipend with prior permission. Sickness Certificate has to be produced within 10 days after proceeding on leave.

**1.5** Students found guilty of misconduct, indiscipline and unauthorized absence shall be liable to disciplinary action including expulsion from college by the Dean / Principal and cancellation of registration by the University.

**1.6** The examination will be held at the centre fixed by the Board. A center once allotted will not be changed. The candidate shall abide by the rules and regulations of the Board failing which his/her candidature will be cancelled.

**1.7** The subject , course and college-wise distribution of all Post Graduate Degree and Diploma seats are shown in the Table 1 to 5. The list of unrecognized Degree/Diploma seats are shown in the Annexure 2. The candidate is warned that at the stage of counselling if an unrecognized degree or diploma course is opted by him and allotment is accepted by the candidate, it will be at the candidate's own risk and responsibility. Such a seat once allotted will not be changed.

**1.8 RESERVATION :-** 20% Seats are reserved for candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribe, 16% seats are reserved for candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste and 14% seats are reserved for candidates belonging to Other Backward Classes other than the creamy layer of OBC of Madhya Pradesh or as amended from time to time.

- (1) Reservation for woman candidates shall be 30% according to merit cum option in each category.
- (2) The minimum percentage of marks in Pre P.G. Entrance Examination for eligibility for admission to Post Graduate Medical and Dental courses shall be 40% for SC / ST / OBC candidates and 50% for Unreserved category candidates. While preparing the merit list of Non-Service candidates for Medical (MD & MS) Course, the Board shall calculate 50% prorata of the total marks obtained in MBBS Part I and Part II and add it to the marks obtained in Pre-PG Entrance examination.

Note : The merit list of Non-Service candidates for Medical (MD & MS) course shall be prepared through prorata rule.

- Non-Service candidate's applying for Medical MD &MS course shall have to mention their MBBS Final Professional Part-I and Part-II marks along with the Maximum Marks in the OMR Application Form.
- The marks obtained in Part-I and Part-II will be added and the percentage with the total maximum marks of Part-I and Part-II will be calculated.
- 50% of the percentage of marks so calculated will be then added to the marks obtained in the test. Thereafter the merit list will be prepared by the Board.
- The prorata rule will not be applicable to In-Service and candidates applying for MDS course. For such candidates, only the marks obtained in the Pre-PG entrance examination shall be taken in to account.
- The maximum marks for different courses will be as follows:

- (3) The candidate claiming to be a candidate belonging to SC / ST / OBC category of Madhya Pradesh shall have to produce the original certificate at the time of counselling. **No certificate is to be enclosed along with the application form. However, original certificates and their photocopies shall be required at the time of counselling.**
- (4) For Physically Handicapped persons who are bonafide residents of Madhya Pradesh and who belong to ST, SC, OBC and Unreserved category, three percent (3%) seats are reserved for admission to P.G. courses. Reservation will be horizontal. According to the above reservation if eligible candidates are not available the above mentioned seats shall be filled from the related category only.

**The candidate claiming admission against these seats will have to produce a valid certificate at the time of counselling, in the prescribed form from District Medical Board and Eligibility Certificate from Superintendent Vocational Rehabilitation Centre for Physically Handicapped, Government of India, Ministry of Labour, Napier Town, Jabalpur. (Seats shown on Table-5). However it will be governed by guidelines framed by MCI.**

Following disabilities are not eligible -

1. Upper limb Handicapped
2. Visually Handicapped
3. Hearing Handicapped
4. Lower limb more than 70% Handicapped

**Certificate of eligibility should not be more than 3 months old at the time of counselling.**

- (5) In PG Degree and Diploma Courses 20% of seats are reserved for In-Service Medical officers of Govt. of M.P. under of Public Health and Family Welfare Department . (**In-Service candidate** - Table No. 2 & 4) For these In-Service candidates selection process and conditions for degree and diploma courses will be as under.

## 1.9 Selection Criteria :- (In Service Candidate)

### 1.9.1 Medical Officer

- (a) Only those candidates, who would complete 3 years service on 30<sup>th</sup> April 2008 as Medical Officer, in the Public Health and Family Welfare Department will be eligible, A candidate who is working consecutively as contractual Medical Officer in Public Health and Family Welfare Department of the State Government and has completed 3 years of service at one place will also be eligible as In-Service candidate. A candidate who is working consecutively on contractual basis in Public Health & Family Welfare Department of the State Government on the post mentioned above for more than 3 years has to **execute a bond for serving under the State Govt. in notified rural areas for at least 5 years, after completing P.G. degree/diploma course. As per Govt. instruction the bond is for Rs. 3.00 Lacs for Post Graduate Degree and for Rs. 2.00 Lacs for Post Graduate Diploma Course.**
- (b) All those candidates, who have served for three consecutive years in rural areas on regular or contractual basis will also be eligible, even if they have not completed a total of five years of service. Relaxation for such candidates with less than 5 years of service will , however be subject to condition that they will be entitled for selection to Post Graduate Courses in Obstetrics and Gynaecology/Paediatrics/ Anaesthesia/Pathology/Radiotherapy/ Radiodiagnosis only.
- (c) The maximum age limit for the selection of In-Service candidates will be 45 years on 30<sup>th</sup> April 2008.
- (d) The In-Service candidates, who have done Post Graduation in one subject (Degree/Diploma) will not be eligible for admission in another subject.

**1.9.2 APPLICATION :-**

The In-Service candidates will have to submit their application in prescribed form (given in the Rule Book) to the Public Health and Family Welfare Department of the Government of Madhya Pradesh, Bhopal. In-Service candidates shall have to produce a No-objection Certificate obtained from their Department at the time of counselling.

**1.10 Examination and Merit list:-**

There will be one common entrance examination for Post Graduate Entrance conducted by Madhya Pradesh Professional Examination Board. The In-Service candidates will be selected on the basis of the same entrance examination. The In-Service candidates shall have to secure minimum qualifying marks in the Pre-PG Entrance Examination, as prescribed in the rules for admission. The Madhya Pradesh Professional Examination Board will prepare and declare separate merit list of selected In-Service candidates. Total Marks for the examination for In-Service candidates shall be 200. Such In-Service candidates, declared successful will be considered for final Merit list by addition of marks calculated on the following basis.

The inter-se merit of the selected In-Service candidate shall be prepared by adding marks based on weightage for their services rendered in rural areas. The candidates serving in rural area will get a maximum of 50 marks, allotted on the following basis:-

- (a) For Government service of one year duration while posted in rural area, a weightage of maximum 06 marks will be given . For the service in rural area , the maximum gain of marks will be 30 or 20 as per following marks for one year each, for five years.

If the regular services are rendered in Primary Health Centre or Community Health Center situated in rural area, then 06 marks will be given for one year and if regular services are rendered in Primary Health Centre or Community Health Center in Nagar Panchayat Area, which has been formed under the "M. P. Municipalities Act, 1961" then 04 marks will be given for one year's service.

- (b) For every year of regular service, additional marks will be given, if the rural area comes under tribal sub plan and if such services are rendered in Primary Health Center the candidate will get maximum 20 additional marks at the rate of 04 additional marks per year for five years and for rendering such regular services at Community Health Center, in a tribal sub plan area the candidate will get total additional 10 marks at the rate of 02 marks per year for five years.
- (c) For the purpose of this Rule, during the period of service of candidate, while posted in rural area or Nagar Panchayat area or tribal area, if he/she was on unauthorized absence from duty/ any dies-non period/any period of leave without pay /any period on training exceeding 3 months/ attachment in urban area during the tenure of rural service it will **not** be counted for the purpose of calculation of marks for weightage for rural service.
- (d) The final merit list of In-Service candidates will be prepared by Madhya Pradesh Professional Examination Board for counselling on the basis of marks obtained in entrance examination (equivalent to 200 Marks ) and marks secured for weightage of Rural/Tribal Area Service ( equivalent to maximum 50 marks) out of a total of 250 marks.
- (e) In case of two or more candidates obtaining equal marks, the inter-se-merit will be decided as per procedure described in sub- rule (2) of Rule-19.
- (f) The counselling of In-Service candidates will be done by the Medical Education Department.

**1.11 Return to the Department after completing the course:-**

The normal term for PG degree is 36 months and for Post Graduate diploma is 24 months. Candidates completing the tenure will have to come back to their employer Department irrespective of the result of the examination. No extension for continuation of the studies shall be granted under any circumstances.

**1.12 Fee, Bond etc . :-**

Selected Non Service candidates have to execute a bond **as per Government instructions i.e. Rs. 3.00 Lacs for Post-Graduate and Rs. 2.00 Lacs for Diploma courses** at the time of admission for serving under the State Government in the notified rural areas for at least 2 years after completing PG Degree / Diploma Course.

**1.13 Fee Structure :** Every candidate shall have to pay the fee regularly as detailed below:-

1. TUITION FEE (Degree)	Rs.35,000/- Per Annum.
2. TUITION FEE (Diploma)	Rs.35,000/- Per Annum.
3. HOSTEL FEE	Rs.10,000/- Per Annum.
4. STUDENT FUND	Rs. 500/- Per Annum.
5. CAUTION MONEY (Refundable)	Rs. 3,000/-
6. SECURITY DEPOSIT (Refundable)	Rs.10,000/-

**1.14 SECURITY DEPOSIT :**

- (1) Candidate will deposit Rs. 10,000 as security deposit in the form of a demand draft payable to Director, Medical Education, Madhya Pradesh, Bhopal on allotment of a seat during counselling :

Provided that a candidate who belongs to SC / ST category whose parents/Guardians income does not exceed Rs. 1.80 lacs per annum from all sources shall not make any security deposit. Provided that other SC/ST candidates, whose parents/guardians income exceeds Rs. 1.80 lac per annum from all sources and all candidates belonging to OBC category shall be required to deposit only Rs. 2,000/- as security deposit.

- (2) The amount of security deposit shall be refundable without interest after successful completion of the course. In case a candidate does not join the allotted course, subject and institution or discontinues the study in a course and leaves college before completion of the course due to any reason, his/her claims on security deposit shall be forfeited.

**1.15 ELIGIBILITY :**

1.15.1 (i) The candidate must be a bonafide resident of Madhya Pradesh.

OR

The candidate must have passed all MBBS/BDS examinations from a Medical / Dental College of Madhya Pradesh.

OR

(ii) The candidates who are bonafide residents of Madhya Pradesh but have passed M.B.B.S. course from a Medical College outside M.P. recognized by Medical Council of India, New Delhi.

This will also be applicable to those candidates who are to be selected for M.D.S. course.

OR

(iii) Medical officers nominated by Health and Family Welfare department of Government of Madhya Pradesh (In-Service candidates).

1.15.2 (i) Eligible candidate must have undertaken studies in an institution recognized by MCI / DCI.

(ii) Eligible candidate must have completed compulsory internship from a MCI/ DCI recognised institution on or before 31.03.2008.

(iii) Eligible candidate must permanently be registered by Madhya Pradesh Medical/Dental Council (and /or MCI/DCI) on or before 30.04.2008.

1.15.3 (i) No candidate including In-Service candidate will be entitled for doing post graduation for a period of 3 years, if a seat was allotted to him/her through All India or State Post Graduate Entrance Examination and he/she did not join or joined & left the seat thereafter, due to any reason during 2005-2007.

(ii) A candidate who is admitted to PG course in Government Autonomous Medical College in Madhya Pradesh through All India Entrance Examination 2008 and also got selected for Madhya Pradesh Post Graduate Entrance Examination, 2008 is eligible to

participate in counselling scheduled for selected candidates in Madhya Pradesh Post Graduate Entrance Examination, 2008. However he / she will have to resign from All India Seat in case, he/she opts for a seat from State Quota at such counselling.

- Note:- (i) Vide Government of Madhya Pradesh Medical Education Department order no. F-5-15/03/55/ME/1, Dated 26-12-03 the students admitted to M.B.B.S. course in 2002 can appear in Post Graduate entrance examination, 2008 provided that if a student qualifies, he/she has to submit a No objection Certificate from Public Health & Family Welfare Department, Government of Madhya Pradesh, before admission is given in a Post Graduate course.**
- (ii) All In-Service candidates will have to appear in Common Entrance Examination conducted by Madhya Pradesh Professional Examination Board . Separate merit/waiting list will be made of In-service candidates after adding the qualifying marks scored in Common Entrance Examination and marks allotted to them by Department of Public Health and Family Welfare. Counselling will be done as per the final Merit/Waiting list.**

**1.16 EXAMINATION :-**

- (1) The entrance examination for MS/MD/MDS/Diploma will be conducted in ENGLISH medium only.**
- (2) There shall be one paper of three hours duration. The question paper shall have two parts "A" & "B".**
- (3) In objective type questions one mark will be awarded for each correct answer. No mark will be awarded for an incorrect response or multiple marking or for an unanswered question.**
- (4) The examination shall be of the standard of MBBS examination and shall cover all subjects of MBBS Course.**
- (5) The tentative number of questions of each subject for degree and Diploma (MD/MS) are as shown below.**

**1.17 ADMISSION TO PG DENTAL DEGREE COURSES :-**

- (1) The examination will be conducted on the same pattern as for Post Graduate Medical Degree/Diploma Course as described earlier and the General Principle as prescribed for MD/MS Course shall apply to P.G. Dental Course i.e., M.D.S.
- (2) **There shall be one paper of three hours duration. The question paper shall have two parts "A" and "B".**
- (3) The examination shall be of the standard of BDS examination and shall cover all subjects of BDS Course.
- (4) **The tentative number of question in each group of subject are as shown below :**

In case eligible candidate is not available then the seat will be filled up as described in sub-rule (11) of Rule 20.

### **1.18 DECLARATION OF RESULT :-**

The Board will conduct the examination, evaluate the answer sheets, prepare the Merit list/Waiting list and declare the result. The allotment of a seat to

eligible candidate in Subject / Course / College will be done by counselling on Merit cum option basis. Counselling will be done by Directorate of Medical Education at Gandhi Medical College, Bhopal.

**1.19 MERIT LIST :-**

- (1) The merit list will consist of the number of candidates equal to the number of seats available for allotment in State quota. The waiting list will consist of all successful candidates, who have scored not less than 50% marks in Unreserved category and 40% marks in reserved category. Separate merit and waiting list will be prepared for In-Service and non service (Open) candidates. Separate merit and waiting lists shall be prepared for In-Service candidates after adding the qualifying marks scored in Common entrance test and marks allotted by the Department of Public Health and Family Welfare.

Counselling shall be done as per the final merit/waiting list. The Board will prepare a merit list inclusive of all category of candidates including physically handicapped also.

(2) **Inter - Se - Merit**

In case two or more candidates obtaining equal marks in the entrance examination, the merit will be decided as per procedure indicated below-

- (a) A candidate, who scores more marks in Part "B" of the question paper will be kept higher in the merit list.
- (b) For candidates scoring equal marks even in part "B" of the question paper, the candidate older in age will be placed higher in the inter-se-merit of such candidates.

**1.20 COUNSELLING :**

- (1) The allotment of seats shall be made to the candidates through counselling on personal appearance. The Counselling committee will consist of -
- (i) Director Medical Education or his authorised representative.
- (ii) Director, Madhya Pradesh Professional Examination Board or his representative.

- (iii) Director, Medical Services.
- (iv) All Deans of the Autonomous Medical Colleges of Madhya Pradesh.
- (v) Principal of the Autonomous Dental College, Indore.
- (vi) Representative of reserved category not below the rank of an Associate Professor nominated by the State Government.
- (vii) Two nominated representative of local Medical College.

**Note:-**Director Medical Services will remain present personally throughout the counselling of In-Service candidates, Director Medical Services will also be completely responsible for the counselling of In-Service candidates.

- (2) **The programme for counselling will be published in the leading newspapers of the state. Separate call letters will not be sent to the candidates.**
- (3) In case of a candidate's inability to appear in person for the counselling, he / she can send his / her authorised representative with an undertaking and authority letter.
- (4) The candidates or their representatives will travel for the counselling at their own cost.
- (5) Candidate or his/her representative will not be allowed to enter the area specified for the counselling without showing the P.P.G.-2008 EXAMINATION MARKSHEET.
- (6) The candidate or his / her authorised representative who comes without original documents, along with a set of two attested photocopies of each original document, will not be eligible to participate in the counselling.
- (7) The candidates or their authorised representatives will wait for their turn in order of merit. They will be called in small groups of 10-20 for scrutiny i.e. verification of original documents and if found eligible, shall further be permitted for the counselling, where they shall exercise their option for allotment of any one of the available seats, which will be final and

the same will be allotted to them and the allotment letter will be issued on payment of Bank Draft payable to Director, Medical Education, Madhya Pradesh, Bhopal as per Rule 14.

- (8) **If the candidates or his/her representatives due to any unavoidable circumstances does not remain present on the date and time fixed for them for scrutiny of the documents and counselling, then such candidates, if they come afterwards, will be considered only at the stage, where the counselling is progressing irrespective of their merit. They will be considered only if the counseling of their category is going on and allotment done earlier to other candidates on the basis of their merit will remain unchanged . This rule will be applicable to candidates of all categories.**
- (9) **Counselling of In-Service candidates will be done first & category wise in the following sequence.**

**I IN-SERVICE**

- A. ST Category
- B. SC Category
- C. OBC Category
- D. Unreserved Category

In case eligible In-Service candidates to the extent of reservations in any category are not available, the vacant seats of that category will be filled up by making available to other In-Service categories as given below :-

- (a) The vacant seats of ST category shall be filled up by the eligible SC category candidates.
- (b) The vacant seats of SC category shall be filled up by eligible ST category candidates.

- (c) In case the eligible candidates to the extent of reservation in ST and SC categories are not available, the vacant seats shall be filled up by eligible OBC category candidates.
- (d) In case the eligible candidates are not available in these three reserved categories in the above manner, the vacant seats shall then be filled up by the eligible Unreserved category candidates.
- (10) Seats remaining vacant after counselling (allotment) of In-Service candidates shall be made available to Non Service (Open) candidates category wise.
- (11) **Counselling of Non-Service candidates will be done according to following sequence category wise :-**

**II. NON SERVICE**

- A. ST Category
- B. SC Category
- C. OBC Category
- D. Unreserved Category

In case the eligible candidates to the extent of reservations in any category i.e. Non-Service (Open) and Physically Handicapped are not available, the vacant seats of that category will be filled up by making available to other categories as given below :-

- (a) The vacant seats of ST category shall be filled up by the eligible SC category candidates.
- (b) The vacant seats of SC category shall be filled up by eligible ST category candidates.
- (c) In case the eligible candidates to the extent of reservation in ST and SC categories are not available, the vacant seats shall be filled up by eligible OBC category candidates.

(d) In case the eligible candidates are not available in these three reserved categories in the above manner, the vacant seats shall then be filled up by the eligible Unreserved category candidates.

(12) (a) **The candidate from reserved category has to produce permanent caste certificate from Competent Authority in prescribed Proforma. In case of failure to do so the candidate will not be eligible for reservation. The candidate will be responsible for this lapse. Temporary caste certificate and caste certificate with expiry date will not be accepted.**

**Note : 'Competent Authority' and 'Prescribed Proforma' refers to that-which has been specified by the Government of Madhya Pradesh in the General Administration Department for this purpose.**

(b) **The candidate from reserved category has to produce income certificate of the current year i.e. financial year 2007-2008 compulsorily at the time of counselling.**

(13) A candidate belonging to ST/SC/OBC category, whose name also appear in the Merit/Waiting list of unreserved category beside the Merit/Waiting list of his/her own reserved category will have an option during counselling to select the seat from reserved category or unreserved category.

(14) The number of seats available to the State from All India Quota (Degree & Diploma course separately) will be distributed in all the categories **in service and open category** in the same ratio, as prescribed for State Quota seats and these seats will be distributed to a subject, course and college, which will be decided by **draw of lots** by the candidates representing each category in the presence of the Allotment committee.

In case of any dispute regarding the number of seats to be added to a category the highest fraction shall be taken into consideration and shall be given preference.

- (15) "If any candidate who does not wish to be admitted to any of the subjects/ courses available at the time of her/his counseling, he/she may give "opt for waiting" option in writing and his/her name will be placed in waiting list in order of merit. If any seat fall vacant on or before 31st May 2008 in any Medical/Dental Colleges in any subject, the name of such candidate shall be considered on the basis of merit at the time of allotment of vacancies arising due to any reason for admission of the said category".

**1.21 ADMISSION :** Consequent upon a candidate's allotment for a subject, course and a college by counselling, he/she shall report on the notified date and time to the Dean / Principal of the College concerned.

- (1) The Admission committee consisting of Dean / Principal, two Professors and at least two Medical teachers belonging to reserved category shall also verify the original documents and if found eligible, shall give admission in a subject, course and the college allotted to the candidate.
- (2) Once admitted either through All India or State quota, all original certificates shall be kept by the college and a certificate to that effect will be issued to the candidate by the college authorities.
- (3) Original documents shall be returned to the candidates only on completion of their tenure or their resignation or leaving the seat of the course and the college due to any reason.
- (4) **A candidate so admitted to a particular subject, course/category and college will not be entitled for any change on any ground.**
- (5) No admission in P.G. Course/Subject/College will be made after 31<sup>st</sup> May 2008 as per guidelines issued by MCI in pursuance of direction laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court Judgement dated 11.09.02 MCI Vs. Madhu Singh & Othrs.
- (6) **The claim of the candidates, who do not join by the last date of joining / joined and left / joined and remained absent for a period of continuous fifteen days without prior permission of the Head of the Institution, shall be forfeited and allotment/admission given shall be deemed to have been cancelled.**

(7) **The academic session shall commence from 02.05.2008 Last date up to which students can be admitted against vacancies arising due to any reason is 31.05.2008.**

(8) **Fee refund** - Deposited fee will be refundable only if the admission is cancelled by the candidate 6 days before the closing date of admission or 25<sup>th</sup> May 08. No fee shall be refunded after this period. However 10% processing fee may be deducted by the concerned Institution.

**1.23 EXPLANATION OF RULES :**

The State Government reserves the right to amend any rule and procedure for admission. In case of any dispute related to the interpretation of these rules and amendments relating to them, the decision of the State Government shall be final and binding on all concerned.

**1.24 REPEAL AND SAVING:**

The Madhya Pradesh Medical and Dental PG Entrance Examination Rules, 2007 are hereby repealed :

Provided that any order made or action taken under these rules so repealed shall be deemed to have been made or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.

## CHAPTER - 2

### INSTRUCTIONS AND RULES FOR CONDUCT OF TEST

#### 2.1 Procedure of filling up the OMR Application Form :-

All the entries in the boxes  (into which letters written in CAPITALS - or numbers, have to be entered) should be made using blue dot pen and darken appropriate bubbles  under each box evenly using HB pencil. Since the OMR application form will be read by machine, ensure that you fill in the bubbles evenly and completely and do not leave any smudges or stray marks on the application form. Applicant is fully responsible for making these entries and mistake in it is his/ her own responsibility.

- Note:
- (i) If entries in boxes differ from those made in bubbles of the OMR application form, then entries in bubbles shall be treated final.
  - (ii) No change will be allowed in any of the entries made by the applicant in the OMR application form, once submitted.
  - (iii) Paste firmly your recent (not more than 6 months old) front view White background passport size photograph at the specified place in the OMR application form. Do not staple, pin or stitch the photograph. Put your signatures using black pen only at the indicated places in the OMR application form. Write your name, name of exam and OMR Application form no. at the back of your Photograph. In the absence of photograph and signature the application form will be rejected.

**IMPORTANT**

The information given in the application form will be verified at the time of counselling/admission from the original documents by the department concerned/institution. Therefore, Later, if it is found that a successful applicant has provided incorrect or false information or withheld some relevant information at the time of filling up the OMR application form, the applicant shall be debarred to get admission or his admission will be cancelled at any time during the course of his/her studies by the dead of the institution/admitting authority/Madhya Pradesh Professional Examination Board, as case may be without giving any notice.

**2.2 DOCUMENTS TO BE ENCLOSED ALONG WITH THE APPLICATION FORM**

No documents are to be enclosed along with the OMR application

- Note:**
- (i) Photocopy of the Application form will not be accepted.
  - (ii) Application form other than the prescribed will not be accepted.
  - (iii) Application forms received by post by hand or through online till the last date of submission of Application form will only be scrutinized. Application form will be scrutinized on the basis of the information filled in such as category, class, sex, domicile, date of birth etc. After selection, the same will be verified by the concerned Department before counselling from the original documents.

**2.3 REASONS FOR REJECTION OF APPLICATION FORM :-**

- (i) Incomplete or incorrectly filled application form.
- (ii) Application form received after the specified last date of receipt of completed application form in MPPEB office.
- (iii) Application form without photograph or/and without the signature of the candidate.
- (iv) Illogical Date of birth.

- (v) (\*) Asterik marked information in the OMR application form (Sr. No. 4, 6, 7, 9, 10, 11, 12 left blank.
- (vi) (\*) Asterik marked information of Sr. No. 21 in OMR application form left blank (only for Non-Service candidates of Medical (MD & MS) Course).

**IMPORTANT**

Applicants must ensure that the OMR application form has been correctly and clearly filled and no column has been left blank or incomplete especially those columns which are marked with asterik.

**2.4 INFORMATION REGARDING REJECTION**

- (i) After the submission of the application form there is no provision of rectification in the entries of the application form.
- (ii) As per the rules the information of rejected application forms along with the reason of rejection will be made available on the website of the Board,

**2.5 DUPLICATE TEST ADMIT CARD (Duplicate TAC)**

If a candidate does not receive the TEST ADMIT CARD (TAC) three days prior to the date of examination, he/she can download the Test Admit Card from the website **[www.vyapam.nic.in](http://www.vyapam.nic.in)** using his six digit OMR application form number. Please note that a candidate will not be permitted to appear in the examination if he/she does not possess TAC or downloaded DuplicateTAC.

**MPPEB RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CANCEL OR WITHDRAW ANY TEST ADMITCARD ISSUED BY IT.**

## **2.7 MATERIALS TO BE CARRIED IN THE EXAMINATION HALL**

- (i) Test Admit Card (TAC)
- (ii) Black ball point pen

No other material such as cellular/mobile phones, calculators, log tables, stray papers etc. should be found in the possession of the candidate in the test hall otherwise the candidate is liable to be registered under Unfair means (UFM).

## **2.8 UNFAIR MEANS (UFM)**

If any candidate is found using unfair means during the examination, which includes, referring to a book/note book/loose sheets, talking, giving assistance or seeking/receiving help from any source, indulging in any mall practice, misbehaviour in any manner in the test hall, harassing or doing harm to other candidates or if any action of the candidate is interpreted by the Observer/ Centre Supdt. as amounting to be adopting unfair means, case will be registered under unfair means and shall be dealt with accordingly. The answer sheet of the candidate booked under UFM shall not be valued and his/her result shall not be declared.

## **2.9 NATURE OF TEST**

The entrance test shall be of objective type question type questions only, where for each question four possible answers/responses will be given out of which

only one will be correct. The candidate has to select the correct answer and mark the corresponding option (A or B or C or D) on the OMR answer sheet, using Black ball point pen.

## **2.10 MARKS AND TIME ALLOTTED FOR QUESTION PAPER**

The Question paper will contain 200 questions. Total duration of the test will be of 3 hours 15 minutes, out of which the first fifteen minutes are allotted for making the entries in the OMR answer sheet and inspecting the question booklet for any printing or binding errors etc.

## **2.11 SYSTEM FOR VALUATION**

- (i) In objective type question one mark will be awarded for each correct answer. No mark (zero mark) will be awarded for an incorrect response or multiple marking or for an unanswered question. There shall be no negative marking.
- (ii) There is no provision of retotalling or revaluation.

## **2.12 DEFECTIVE QUESTION, THEIR CANCELLATION AND AWARD OF MARKS IN LIEU OF CANCELLED QUESTIONS**

After the completion of examination, Board gets each question of the question paper examined by a group of subject-experts along with the answer suggested by the paper-setter and moderator. If any question is found defective by these experts the question is likely to be cancelled due to:-

- (i) Wrong structuring;
- (ii) More than one option being correct;
- (iii) None of the option being correct;
- (iv) Any printing error leading to a situation where more than one answer may be correct or none of the answers may be correct. Extra marks in proportion to the marks obtained by him, irrespective of the fact whether the candidate had attempted such cancelled question or not. The key prepared by the Board with the help to subject experts shall be final and binding.

In lieu of the cancelled questions, every candidate is awarded marks in proportion to the marks obtained by him/her irrespective of the fact whether the candidate has attempted such cancelled questions or not. For example. If 2 questions out of total 200 questions are cancelled in a particular question paper and if each correct answer carries 01 marks, then after evaluation it is found that the candidate has secured 90 marks from the remaining 198 questions considered for evaluation purpose then his/her marks for 200 question are computed as under.

$$90 \times 200 / (200-2) = 90.90$$

**Note : All calculations shall be calculated upto two decimal places.**

### **2.13 DECLARATION OF RESULT**

(A) Board will prepare the Merit/ Waiting list as per the admission rules mentioned in Chapter-1. The result shall be displayed on the notice board of MPPEB. Result will also be available on the website: **[www.vyapam.nic.in](http://www.vyapam.nic.in)**

(B) Merit of candidates obtaining equal marks (Inter-se-merit):

In case of two or more candidates obtaining equal marks in the entrance examination, the merit will be decided as mentioned in Chapter -1

### **2.14 MARK SHEET**

Board makes every effort to dispatch the mark sheets by U.P.C. to all the candidates just after the declaration of result, but shall not be responsible for postal delay or loss of mark sheet during transit.

### **2.15 DUPLICATE MARK SHEET**

If a candidate wants to obtain a duplicate mark sheet by post he/she shall have to send an A/C payee bank draft for Rs. 100/- in favour of "M.P. Professional Examination Board, Bhopal" payable at Bhopal and the duplicate mark sheet shall be dispatched by Registered Post. In case a candidate wants the duplicate mark sheet from MPPEB office personally on the same day. he/ she shall have

to submit an A/C payee bank draft before 1:00 PM personally in the office of MPPEB.

**2.16 CANCELLATION OF ADMISSION**

If it is found that a candidate has succeeded in obtaining admission on the basis of false/incorrect information or withholding relevant facts at any time after admission, admission so granted to the candidate shall be cancelled without any notice at any time during the course of his/her studies by the Head of the Institute/Admitting Authority.

**2.17** The responsibility of M.P. Professional Examination Board is confined to the extent of conducting the Entrance Test and declaring the Merit/Waiting list M.P. Professional Examination Board shall be the final authority for deciding all policies regarding conduct of the Test. If any question relating to the interpretation of "Instructions & Rules" for the conduct of Pre P.G. - 2008 arises, it shall be referred to the Board, whose decision shall be final and binding. The Board reserves the right to amend any rule / procedure for the conduct of the Entrance Test and any modification so made shall be binding.

**2.18 JURISDICTION**

In case of any legal dispute, the jurisdiction shall be limited to High Court of Madhya Pradesh only.

  - (i) To have access to the question booklet, tear of the 4 paper seals carefully. Do not accept a booklet which is either opened or is without seal.
  - (ii) Tally the number of pages and the number of questions in the booklet with the information printed on the cover page. Also carefully verify that all the inner pages of the question booklet bear the same set (A or B or C or D) as printed on the front cover page. 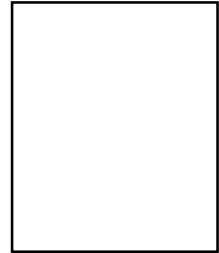
